### \* EXPLANATION OF FEES & LEVIES (Applied each Term)

#### SCHOOL FEES

These fees are calculated based on the recommendations of Brisbane Catholic Education and the College Board. Senior Levy is an additional \$160 for Year 11/12 students.

#### CAPITAL LEVY

This is a compulsory levy charged per family. It is used to meet current and future commitments for building projects.

This levy is NOT tax deductible.

#### P&F LEVY

This levy is collected on behalf of the Mt Maria College P&F Association. The funds are used to complete projects at the discretion of the P&F Committee.

#### RESOURCE & ACTIVITY LEVY

Mt Maria College provides one levy combining subject levies, school camps & excursions and year end activities for each year level. The Text book levy is included in this levy.

#### ICT LEVY

This levy is for all technology requirements of the College

#### LAPTOP LEVY

This levy relates to the 1:1 laptop purchase for students starting in Y07/Y08/Y09/Y10 2018. Yr 10 Students now receive a new laptop for Y10/11/12
